NOTES:

The necessary (by state guidelines) **autopsy in Week 10** was ordered on a truck driver's spouse who was a passenger on a commercial load trip originating in Canada. This is required due to the age of the decedent (59yo), being associated with a work environment (transportation company), possibly a chemically induced death (prescription drugs), and due to citizenship (Canadian). The preliminary cause was found, pending toxicology results.

I have started an account with a mobile x-ray company that will reduce associated costs of autopsies that require x-ray scans. We will receive the Medicare rate which is much lower than the hospital billing rate.

The Coroner's Office has one fully trained **deputy**, two deputies in training, and two people in the interview process to become a deputy. Deputy Coroners only receive pay when they take call upon completion of their training.

The Coroner's office receives \$50 per **cremation** permit issued. I am now using this fund to purchase criminal investigation supplies, thereby reducing other General Fund line items as appropriate.
