### **Administrator Report**

Dustin Harmon discussed the budget. We are 6 months into current budget, starting to pull data for next budget. Identifying where there is a lack of revenue in certain line items with variance reports. We will be doing amendments to Sheriff's next budget for state cannabis revenue.

### **Public Comment**

Peggy Washburn: Advice from attorney will pass out. Friday I came to courthouse for copies of Chris Sutter's Submission. She received a copy of the March minutes. Spoke with Jessica Barker about information Chris Sutter submitted. Was told by Jessica I could not have his personal information. It was his private property. Chairperson, Jenny Waggoner reminded Peggy, this is not a public hearing.

James R Myers, Attorney for Peggy Washburn, stated since the public hearing is set on this agenda I have no further comment.

Susan Tackett stated she is located 1 mile west of proposed location of transfer station. Then she reiterated first step of EPA application. On March 19, 2021 application with Effingham County was approved. She is against this transfer station, claims health concerns, sanitation concerns & wind. Susan always cleans 4.5 mile stretch of highway daily. Why bother after transfer station? Other concerns are, increased traffic complaints and noise complaints. She requests the county board to read Sutter's file completely. Read as a neighbor. Reiterated 9 EPA criteria to be understood and followed.

### **Motion/Vote-Reappointment to Brownstown Fire Protection District**

Matt Hall made a motion to approve the reappointment of Jack Biggs, as Trustee for the Brownstown Fire Protection District, for a term of 3 years, ending April 30, 2024. Jacob Harris seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote.

### **Motion/Vote-Reappointments to Fayette County Board of Review**

Matt Hall made a motion to approve the reappointments of Harold Baumann, 101 Woodland Hills Court, Vandalia, IL 62471 and Keith R Schaal, 112 N Kennedy Blvd, Vandalia, IL 62471, each for a 2 year term to the Fayette County Board of Review to begin June 1, 2021 and ending May 31, 2023. Jacob Harris seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote.

### **Motion/Vote-Appointment to ETSB board**

Matt Hall made a motion to approve appointment of Steve Barker to ETSB Board to fill the unexpired term of Jeff Beckman, until June 2022. Discussion: Merrell Collins stated Steve Barker is on city council. This is a conflict with 911 board. Jacob Harris seconded the motion. Merrell Collins voted No. The motion passed by vote.

### **Motion/Vote-Renewal of Liquor License**

Matt Hall made a motion to approve the renewal of Liquor License for OB's Place. Jacob Harris seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote.

### **Ordinance 2021-05-04-A: Sheriff Employees Immunity-Struck from Agenda**

Ordinance 2021-05-04-A: An Ordinance Guaranteeing Qualified Immunity to Employees of the Fayette County Sheriff's Office. Chairperson Jenny Waggoner stated she was striking this from the agenda for further research.

**Resolution 2021-05-04-B: Culverts 4 miles west of St Peter**

Matt Hall made a motion to approve the following item: A Resolution to approve the "Local Agency Agreement" and related "Addenda" with the Illinois Department of Transportation to replace the box culverts 4 miles west of St Peter on County Highway 23 (St Peter Road). Section 11-00120-01-DR. Jacob Harris seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote.

**Resolution 2021-05-04-C: \$8,000 from County Bridge Fund**

Matt Hall made a motion to approve the following item: A Resolution to appropriate \$8,000 from the County Bridge Fund to replace a culvert 3 miles southeast of Shobonier, on 1200 St., in Kaskaskia Township. Jacob Harris seconded the motion. The motion passed by vote.


